
Downloading Electronic Apostilles

When you requested an Electronic Apostille, if you asked for the option to download it via the internet, you can do so using this form. To do this you will need the following data:

- A username, which is the same as your National Identification Card (DNI) number or Foreign National Identification Number (NIE). Note that you must enter all the digits including, where applicable, zeros on the left.
- An access code. This code is printed on the request receipt you will have received from the Competent Authority before which you submitted the Electronic Apostille request.

Enter the two items of data in the appropriate fields. Additionally, in the last field, you must key in a set of six characters which are presented to you $^{(^{\circ})}$ and click on the **Enter** button:




(*) This is a form security mechanism which helps to ensure that it is indeed a person accessing the site, thus preventing any possible automated "attacks" attempting to violate access control. If you have difficulty identifying the characters presented, you can click on them to change them for other characters.


You will be taken to a welcome window where you will have to click on the link **List of Apostilles** to view the list of Electronic Apostilles which are available for you to download.



The abovementioned list will be displayed. Choose the selector corresponding to the Apostille you wish to download and then click on the **View Detail** button:




A form will be displayed showing details of the Apostille request; at the bottom of this form is an **Apostille** button that enables you to open or download the Electronic Apostille, as shown below:
